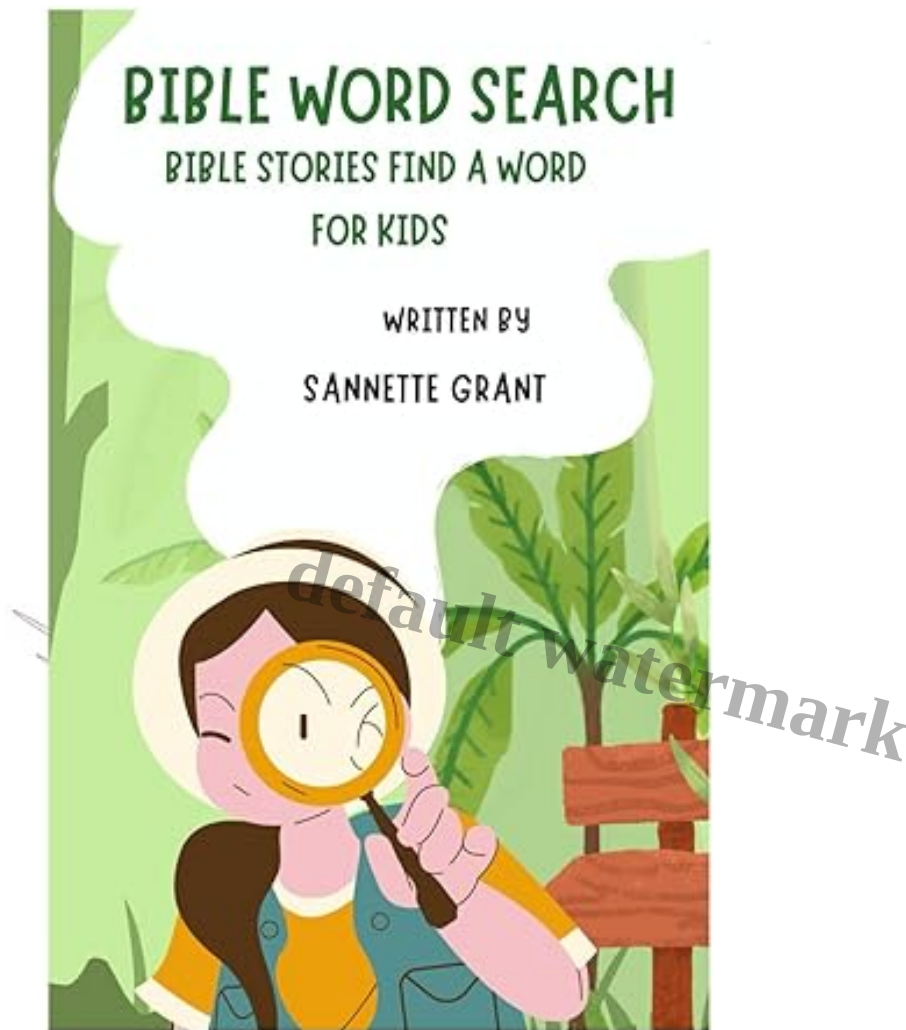

Enhances Comprehension

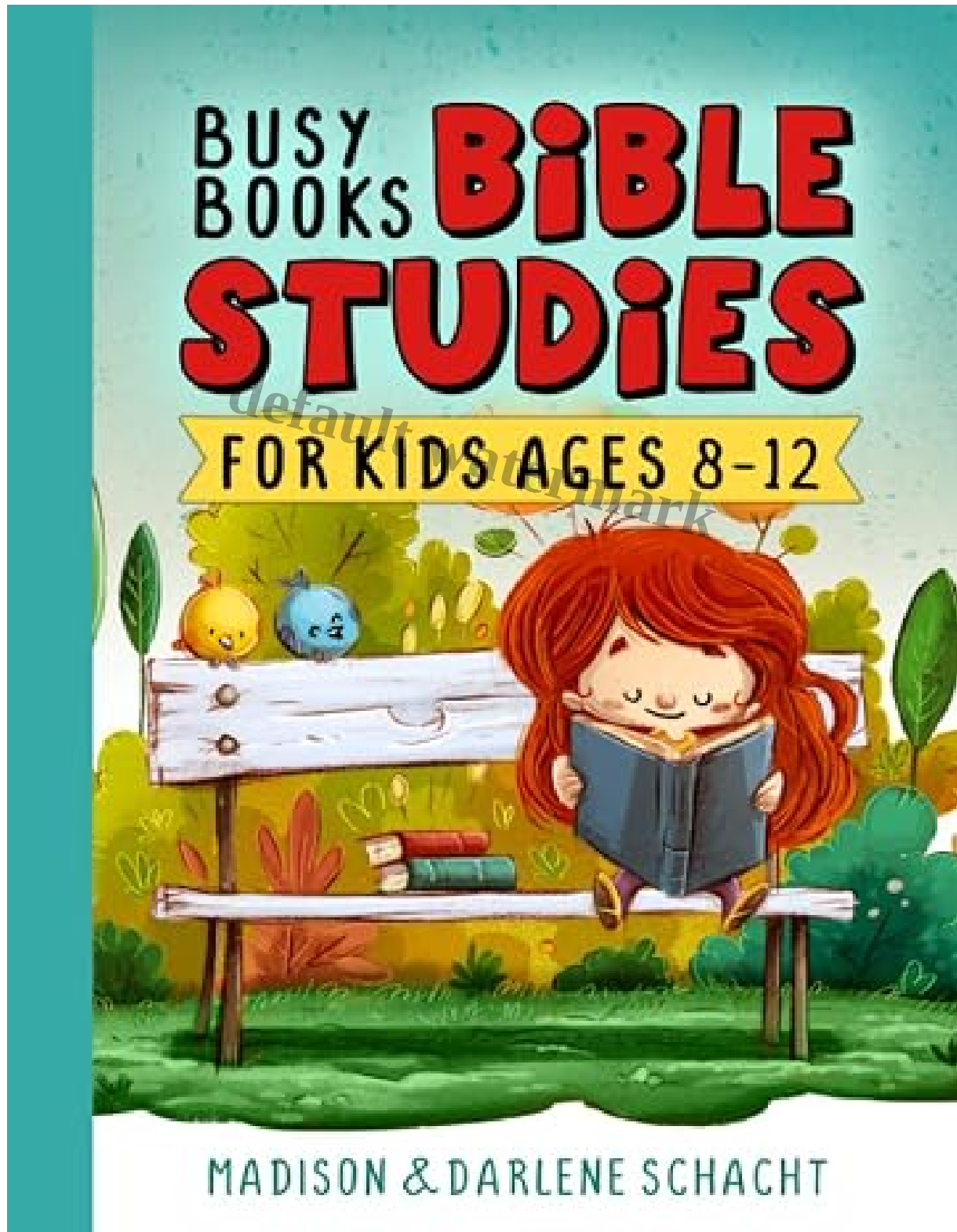
