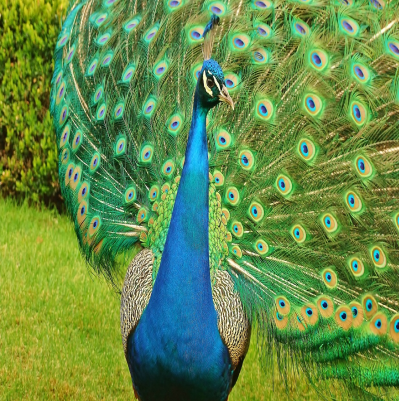
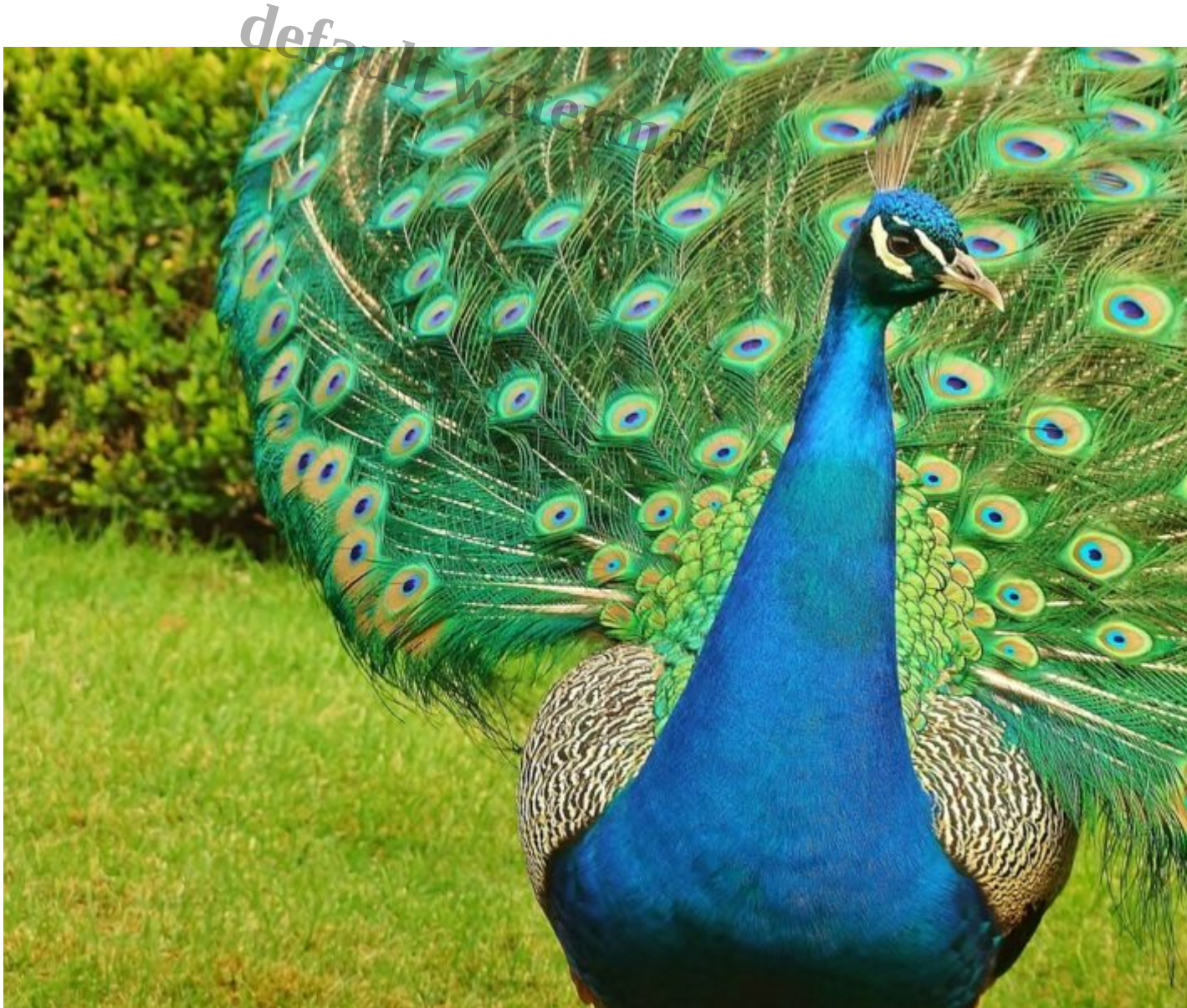




Craft, Books, Puzzles And 12 Bible Verses About Pride To Teach Kids Humility

but he gives grace to the humble

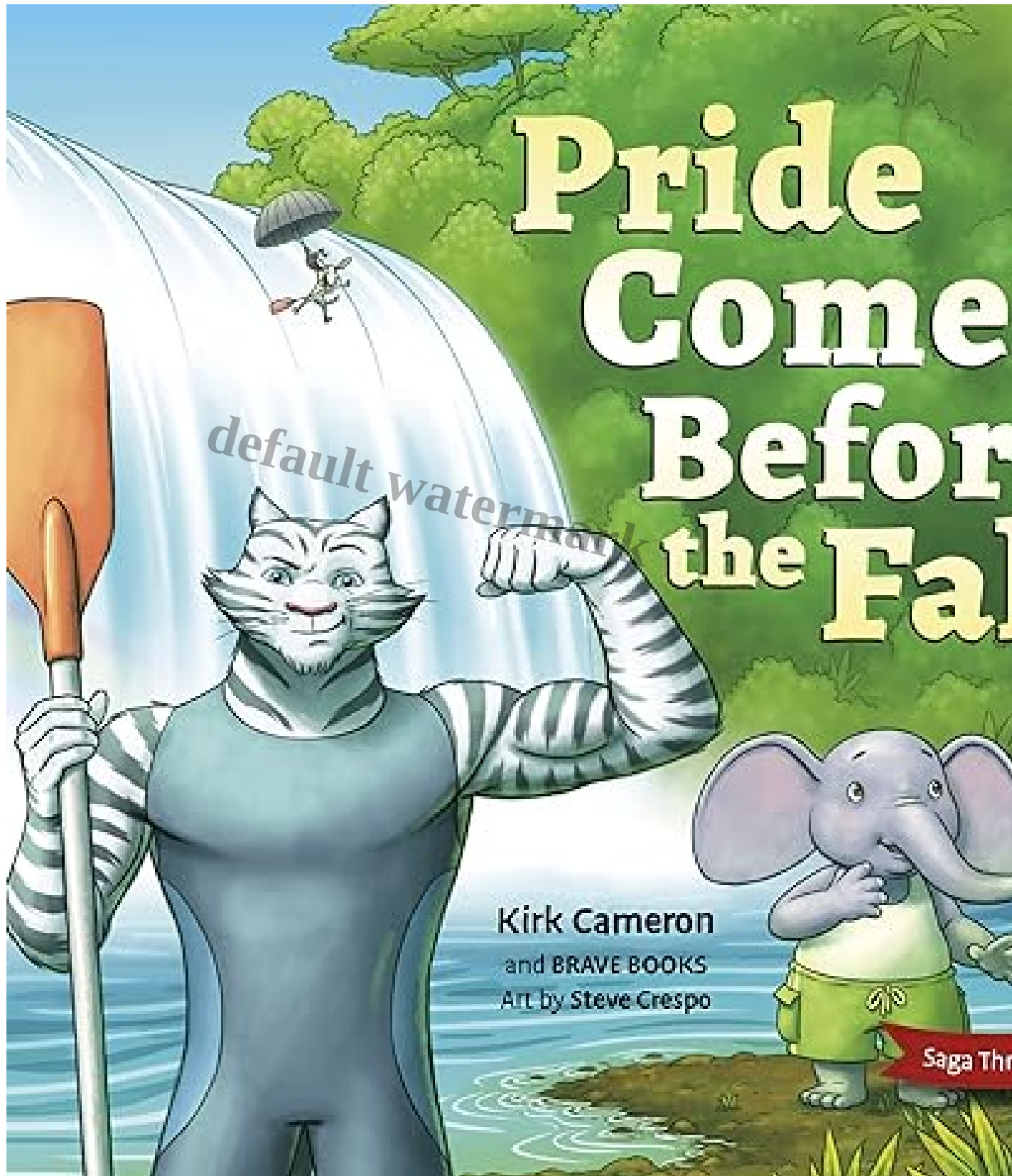

Books and Bible Verses About Pride

There are many authors who have written about pride. As you teach your kids bible verses about pride, some of the books you and your kids can read include Percy The Prideful Peacock, Fool Moon Rising, The BibleMan Adventure on Humility and Pride Goes Before The Fall. After reading these books you can share with your kids bible verses about pride that will show what the bible says about pride and the importance of humility.

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Kirk Cameron in his book [Pride Comes Before The Fall](#) tells the story of Valor who doesn't think he will win the Great Raka Rapids Race with Kevin as his teammate. Valor's pride causes him and his

partner to land in a tight spot. Valor then recognizes that some things are far more important than winning. Valor and Kevin learn about humility and so will kids 3 to 12 years as they read this 48 page adventurous book with great illustrations.

Bible Verses About Pride-How To Overcome Pride Biblically?

After reading the story about Pride Comes Before The Fall by Kirk Cameron, parents can teach their kids Proverbs 16:8 which basically says that when people are proud they will be made humble. Something will happen to proud people that will bring them low in an attempt to humble them. Let's teach our kids to choose humility instead of pride. Here are two bible verses about pride that shows us that because pride leads to ruin we should overcome it by humbling ourselves before God. We can humble ourselves by prayer, bible study and keeping our minds constantly on God.

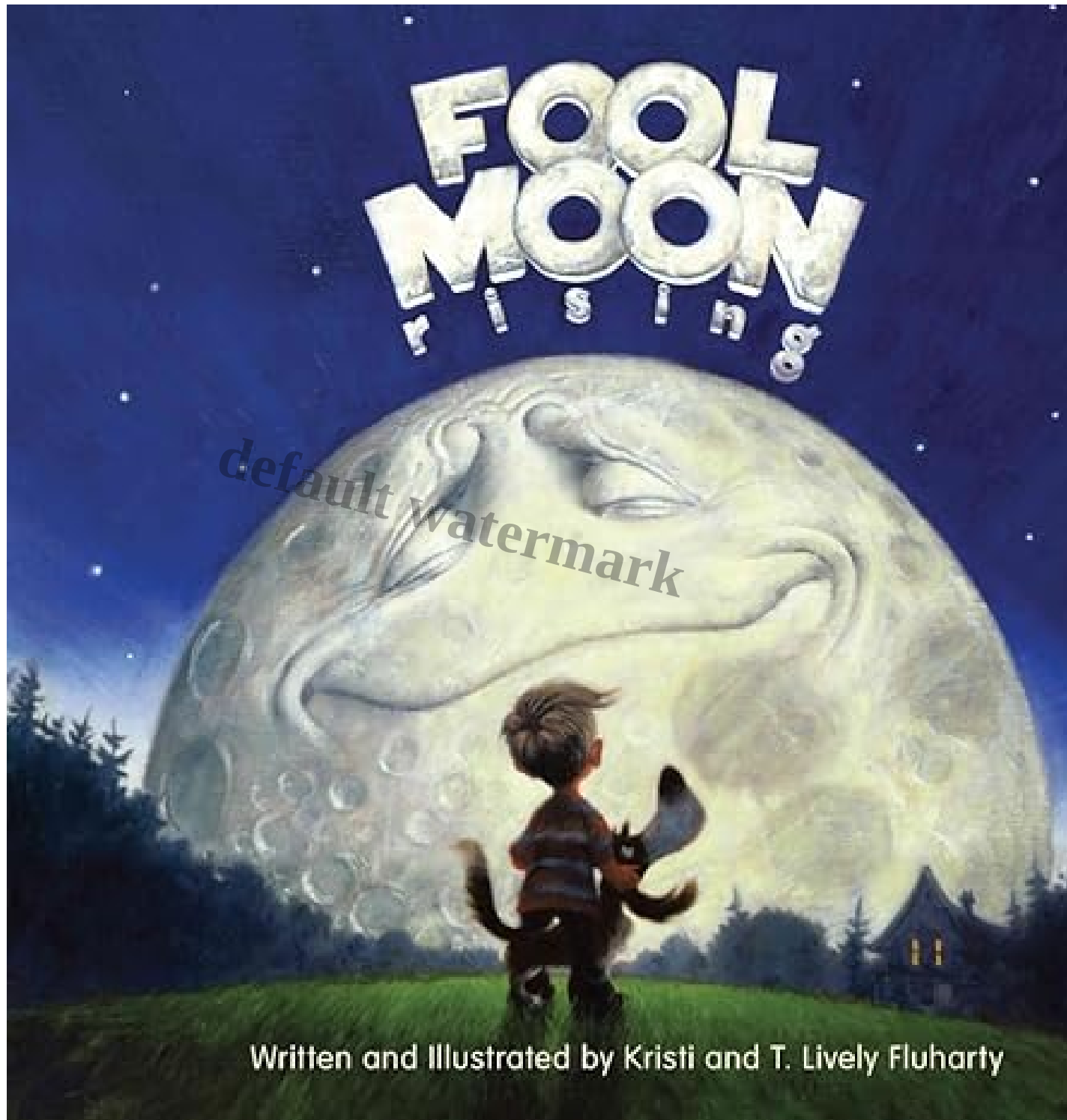
[Proverbs 16:18](#)

Pride leads to destruction.

A proud attitude brings ruin.

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.



[Fool Moon Rising](#) is a 40 page book for kids ages 3 to 7 years which uses rhyming to show the importance of humility and how dangerous pride can be.

In this book the moon is proud and fails to see the true source of its light. It boasts about changing shape throughout each month but one day realizes the true nature of its light.

The readers of this book will be reminded that everything we have comes from God. So, in the same way the moon learns to boast only of the sun, we as humans should boast of no other than the Son of God.

Bible Verses About Pride-What Are The Verses About Good Pride?

Can any pride be good? After reading Fool Moon Rising by Kriti and T. Lively Fluharty, parents can read and discuss with their kids Jeremiah 9:23-24. Bible verses about pride, such as Jeremiah 9:23-24 gives good advice. It tells us that if we ever want to boast or feel proud about anything, it should be about God. We should not boast about our wisdom, strength, riches or anything because everything we have is from God and it is not our own. Let's teach our kids to boast only about God as this is the only good pride.

Here are two bible verses about pride to help teach humility.

This is what the Lord says:

Let not the wise boast of their wisdom
or the strong boast of their strength
or the rich boast of their riches,
but let the one who boasts boast about this:
that they have the understanding to know me,
that I am the Lord, who exercises kindness,
justice and righteousness on earth,
for in these I delight, declares the Lord.

Bible Verses About Pride-What Is The Root Cause Of Pride?

After reading Percy the prideful peacock, parents can help their kids learn Daniel 5:20. In Daniel chapter 5 we see the history of Nebuchadnezzar being spoken about. This king because of his proud attitude lost his kingdom and his son instead of being humble also chose to be proud and also lost the kingdom. Teach your kids that a proud attitude can cost us many things, so being humble is always the best choice.

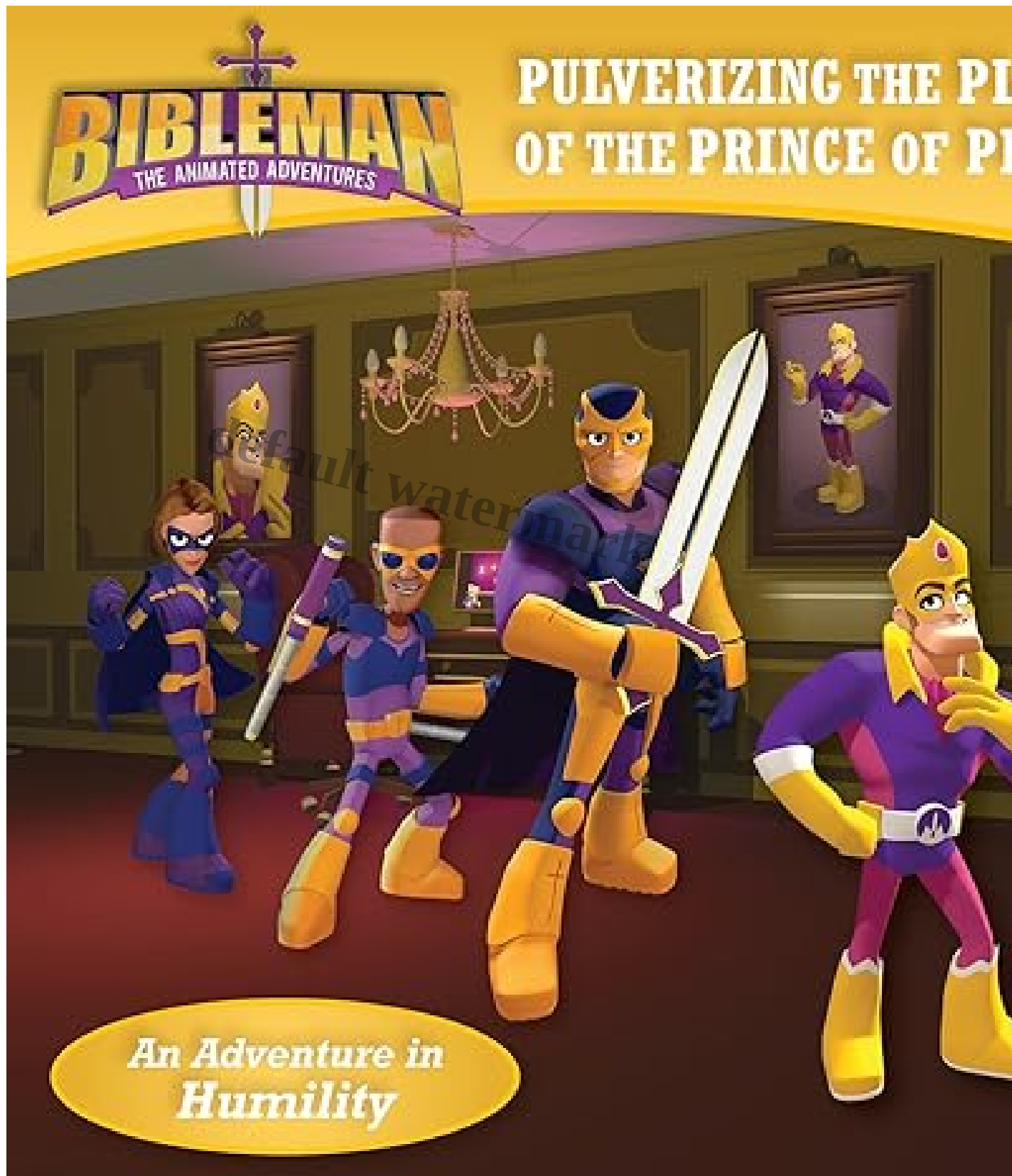
Here are two bible verses about pride to help teach humility. They show us that when our hearts are turned only on ourselves instead of God we can become puffed up. When we choose not to love others it can be a cause for us becoming proud; because love is never proud.

But when his heart became arrogant and hardened with pride, he was deposed from his royal throne and stripped of his glory.

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.

Bible Verses About Pride-How Does God Treat Pride?

After reading this Bibleman Adventure, you and your kids can learn the key text that was apart of the adventure found in Luke 14:11. As you read these bible verses about pride, remind your kids that anyone who thinks of themselves better than others will be made humble, so its always better to just choose humility. So, how does God treat pride? He treats it by humbling the proud person.

Here are two bible verses about pride to help teach humility.

For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

[Romans 12:3](#)

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

Then spake Jesus to the multitude, and to his disciples,

Saying The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:

All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.

For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay them on men's shoulders; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers.

But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments,

And love the uppermost rooms at feasts, and the chief seats in the synagogues,

And greetings in the markets, and to be called of men, Rabbi, Rabbi.

But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, even Christ; and all ye are brethren.

And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, even Christ.

But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.

And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

Woe unto you, ye blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor!

Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?

And, Whosoever shall swear by the altar, it is nothing; but whosoever sweareth by the gift that is upon it, he is guilty.

Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift?

Whoso therefore shall swear by the altar, sweareth by it, and by all things thereon.

And whoso shall swear by the temple, sweareth by it, and by him that dwelleth therein.

And he that shall swear by heaven, sweareth by the throne of God, and by him that sitteth thereon.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Ye blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

Thou blind Pharisee, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness.

Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.

Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets.

Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.

Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?

Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city:

That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!

Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.

For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Every heard of the very humble caterpillar? No not the very hungry caterpillar I did mean the very humble caterpillar. Ms Kelly at [Horizon Kids](#) has a humility craft called the very humble caterpillar. For sure it is a winning craft to use to teach kids that humility is better than pride.

There is a story about humility found in Luke 18:9-14.

[Luke 18:9-14](#)

And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
