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The Promises of God

We want children to learn that they can stand on Godâ??s promises too. As the kids, â??God keeps his promises,â?• song says

[Numbers 23:9](#), NIV says that â??God is not human that he should lie.â?• This means that we can stand on the promises of God.

The promises of God are sure.

[2 Cor 1: 20](#), NIV

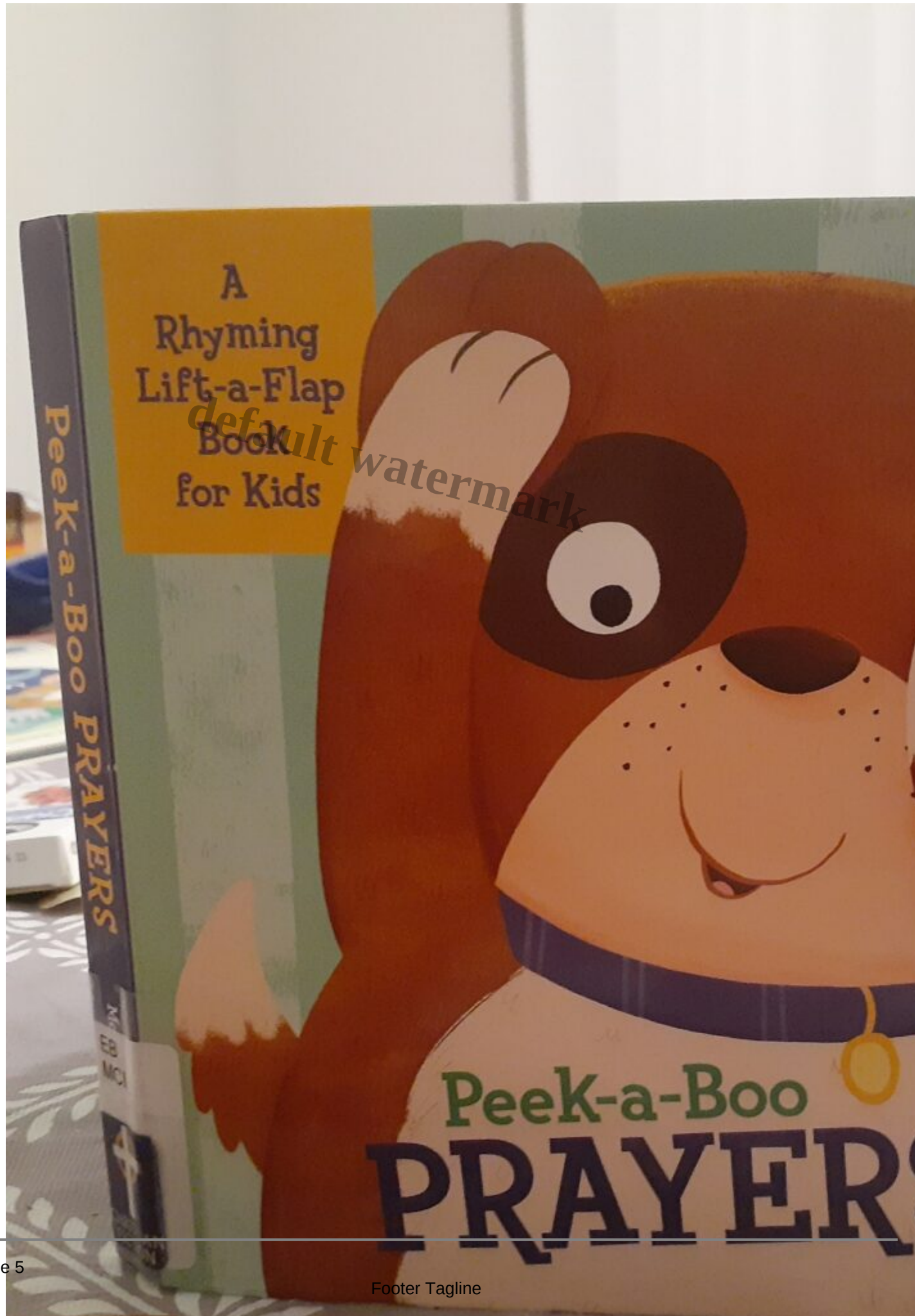
â??For no matter how many promises God has made, they are â??Yesâ?• in Christ.

The bible writers experienced being able to trust the promises of God and spoke of it. One bible author says in [Hebrews 10:23](#), ICB

â??â?we can trust God to do what he promised.â?•

To teach children to stand on God's promises, parents can do the same and speak about standing on the promises of God. The bible encourages parents in [Deuteronomy 6: 7, NIV](#) to "talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up." So parents should talk about God's promises everyday, everywhere, all the time. They should talk about their experience standing on the promises of God.

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A great way to talk about these promises is through reading. [Peek-a-Boo Prayers](#) is a great rhyming lift a flap board book which parents can use to introduce kids to the amazing promises found in the bible. It has colorful illustrations and really cute rhymes. Imagine reading to your child

“Hello God, I’m so thankful you watch over me everyday.” and then underneath the flap it says “Peek-a-boo, God sees you. All the time God sees us. 2 Corinthians 2:17”

There are so many promises in this small book which are worth sharing with your kids as you help them stand on the promises of God.

5 Standing On The Promises Of God Bible Verses

To teach your child to stand on the promises of God, show them in the bible the promises that God made. One standing on the promises bible verse you can share is Deuteronomy 3:8, NIV

[Deuteronomy 3:8](#), NIV

“The Lord goes before you and he will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.”

Children can often be afraid of many things this is a beautiful promise you can share with them to let them know that they are never alone.

Another standing on the promises of God scripture for children is [Proverbs 3: 6](#), ICB

[Proverbs 3: 6](#), ICB

“Remember the Lord in everything you do. And he will give you success.”

Children often wonder how they can do well in their school exams, this is one promise of God that parents can share in those moments.

[Exodus 20: 12](#), NIV

“Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.”

This is one of God’s promises in the bible which lets children know that when they respect their parents they will be blessed by God. This is a beautiful standing on the promises of God scripture for children to know.

[James 4:7](#), NIV

“Submit yourself then to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”

Children often do things they should not do. This promise of God should be shared with all children. This promise of God says that when we commit ourselves to God and tell the devil “No”; God will work it out so that the devil will leave us alone. Isn’t this a great standing on the promises of God scripture for children to know?

Several of God’s promises in the bible remind us that if we make a mistake God will forgive if we ask.

[1 John 1:9](#), NIV

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins.”

5 Prayers For Standing On The Promises Of God

Another way to help children stand on the promises of God, is to pray the promises of God. God’s promises in the bible can be used everyday as part of our prayers.

Jeremiah 28:6

of all the people who stood in the house of the LORD.

6 and the prophet Jeremiah said, ^R"Amen! The LORD do so; the LORD perform your words which you have prophesied, to bring back the vessels of the LORD's house and all who were carried away captive, from Babylon to this place.

1 Kin. 1:36

7 "Nevertheless hear now this word that I speak in your hearing and in the hearing of all the people:

8 "The prophets who have been before me and before you of old prophesied against many countries and great kingdoms—of war and disaster and pestilence.

9 "As for ^Rthe prophet who prophesies of "peace, when the word of the prophet comes to pass, the prophet will be known as one whom the LORD has truly sent."

Deut. 18:22 • Jer. 23:17

10 Then Hananiah the prophet took the ^Ryoke off the prophet Jeremiah's neck and broke it.

Jer. 27:2

11 And Hananiah spoke in the presence of all the people, saying, "Thus says the LORD: 'Even so I will break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon ^Rfrom the neck of all nations within the space of two full years.'" And the prophet Jeremiah went his way.

Jer. 27:7

12 Now the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah, after Hananiah the prophet had broken the yoke from the neck of the prophet Jeremiah, saying,

13 "Go and tell Hananiah, saying, 'Thus says the LORD: "You have broken the yokes of wood, but you have made in their place yokes of iron."

14 'For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "I have put a yoke of iron on the neck of all these na-

tions, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; and they shall serve him. "I have given him the beasts of the field also."

15 Then the prophet Jeremiah said to Hananiah the prophet, "Hear now, Hananiah, the LORD has not sent you, but ^Ryou make this people trust in a ^Rlie.

Ezek. 13:22 • Jer. 27:10; 29:9

16 "Therefore ^Rthus" says the LORD: 'Behold, I will cast you from the face of the earth. This year you shall die, because you have taught ^Rrebellion against the LORD.'

Deut. 13:5

17 So Hananiah the prophet died the same year in the seventh month.

29 Now these are the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem to the remainder of the elders who were ^Rcarried away captive—to the priests, the prophets, and all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried away captive from Jerusalem to Babylon.

2 (This happened after Jeconiah the king, the queen mother, the eunuchs, the princes of Judah and Jerusalem, the craftsmen, and the smiths had departed from Jerusalem.)

3 The letter was sent by the hand of Elasah the son of ^RShaphan, and Gemariah the son of Hilkiah, whom Zedekiah king of Judah sent to Babylon, to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, saying,

4 Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, to all who were carried away captive, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem to Babylon:

5 Build houses and dwell in them; plant gardens and eat their fruit.

6 Take wives and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for

your sons and give your daughters to husbands, so that they may bear sons and daughters—that you may be increased there, and not diminished.

7 And seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, ^Rand pray to the LORD for it; for in its peace you will have peace.

8 For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are in your midst deceive you, nor listen to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed.

9 For they prophesy ^Rfalsely to you in My name; I have not sent them, says the LORD.

10 For thus says the LORD: After ^Rseventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to ^Rreturn to this place.

A beautiful promise of God is found in Jeremiah 29:11, NIV.

Jeremiah 29:11, NIV

“For I know the plans I have for you declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

No matter what happens in life, we can stand on the promises of God that he has a great future in store for us. Pray this promise of God over the life of your child. It may sound something like this.

“Father you promised prosperity, no harm, hope and a great future. Your promises are always yes so in Jesus name I pronounce these blessings upon (insert your child’s name). Amen.

Romans 8:28, NIV

“and we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him.” A prayer to stand on the promises of God as given in this bible verse may sound like:

“Lord you have promised to work things out for the good of those who love you. I am standing on the promises of God as I pray for my child (insert your child’s name) who loves you. No matter what I see around I know that you are working in my child’s favour. I know you are working it out for good. Thank you.”

Matthew 28: 20, NIV

“I surely I am with you always.” A prayer to stand on the promise of God may sound like:

“Thank you for promising to always be with us. I know I can stand on your promise of always being there. I cannot always be with (insert child’s name) but I trust you Lord to always be with (insert child’s name).

Proverbs 22:6, NIV

“Train a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not turn from it.” A prayer for standing on this promise of God may sound like this:

“It is hard to bring up children in this current world but you have promised to be my strength, to be my man of war. Win the battles Lord and may my child be trained to grow and walk in your way and never depart as long as (child’s name) lives.”

Philippians 4:7, NIV

“Do not be anxious about anything but in everything by prayer and petition with thanksgiving present your requests to God. and the peace of God will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Praying this promise of God may sound something like this:

â??Father you have said I should pray about everything instead of being anxious. There are things I feel anxious for as it relates to (childâ??s name). I am putting (childâ??s name) before you and as your word declares, I am claiming the peace you promise to send.â?•
