



Who Is God? Teaching Kids About God In 5 Fun & Meaningful Ways

Who is God? That is a key question to teach kids. Teaching Kids about God is one of the most precious and important responsibilities for Christian parents. It helps lay the foundation for their faith and provides them with a sense of purpose, love, and understanding of the Bible. But where do you begin? Explaining who God is to kids can feel like a grand task, especially when their curious minds ask questions like, “What does God look like?” or “Where does God live?”

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Who Is God? A Kid-Friendly Explanation

1. Who is God? God Is Our Creator

Start by teaching children that God made everything. Show kids the beauty of the world around them. Take them on a nature walk and highlight trees, flowers, animals, the sun, and even their own bodies and tell them that God made everything they see. Genesis 1:1 is a great verse to introduce: “In the beginning, God created the heaven and the earth.” You can also tell the story of the creation of the world and this will help kids understand that God made everything.

2. Who is God? God Is Love

Help kids understand that God’s love is not dependent on whether they are good or bad. Explain that God will love them no matter what and always wants what’s best for them. 1 John 4:8 says:

“God is love.” You can use examples from their daily lives, for example you could explain that you love them a lot and that God’s love is even greater than your love.

3. Who is God? God Is Everywhere

Teach kids that God is always with them, no matter where they go. You can also tell them that the great big word that is used for this is to say that God is omnipresent. The concept that God is always with them can provide comfort and assurance, especially during moments when they feel scared or alone. Psalm 139:7-10 illustrates this very well.

4. Who is God? God Is All-Powerful

The great big word that is used to say that can do anything is omnipotent. Share stories from the Bible that show God’s power, such as parting the Red Sea (Exodus 14:21-22) or Jesus calming the storm (Mark 4:39). God uses His power to care for and help His children.

5. Who is God? God Wants to Know Us Personally

Teach kids that God isn’t far away. He wants a personal relationship with them and the way we have this relationship with God is through bible study and prayer which is a way to talk to God, just like they would a friend or parent. You can start teaching children to pray by using the Our father prayer.

Tips for Teaching Kids About Who Is God

1. Keep It Simple

Use simple language and stories they can understand well. For instance, compare God's care for them to a shepherd caring for sheep (Psalm 23).

2. Be Consistent

Teaching about God isn't a one-time conversation. Instead have discussions about God in everyday life for example during meals, bedtime, or while driving.

3. Use Visual Aids

Visual aids like picture books, videos, or crafts can help children understand better who is God.

4. Read the Bible Together

Choose a kid-friendly version of the Bible, such as *The Beginner's Bible* or *The Jesus Storybook Bible*, to introduce Bible stories in a way that's engaging and age-appropriate. If you are not familiar with these Bibles you can watch this video which shows you these Bibles.

5. Model Faith

Children learn a lot by watching their parents. Let them see you pray, read the Bible, and talk about God.
